# Lent Prayer Guide 2020

For many people, Lent is a time of fasting and giving up things. For others it passes un-noticed. There are others for whom it is like a new season – a new beginning where growth and opportunity is promised. However you approach Lent it is a good time to stop, to re-focus and re-centre on God as we look ahead to Easter week.

This year our verse for the year is from Romans 12:

"For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others" (Romans 12:4-5)

As one body, we are called to care for one another and care for the health of the whole body. One way we do this is in prayer. This prayer booklet is designed, as well us to focus us back onto Jesus, to also direct our prayer for the church and community we live in and serve. Together we stand in prayer and bring our deepest desires for ourselves, the church and community to God. As we pray together may we meet with God, grow in him and rest in his presence, bringing all our burdens to him, as he tells us to do.

Each day has a suggested reading from the Gospel of Mark – if you follow the readings you will have read through the whole of Mark by the end of Lent. Mark is the shortest Gospel, and the readings are short and fast paced all heading towards the events of that first Holy Week. As you read, pause, reflect, and ask God to speak to you and help you to know Christ better as you learn more of him. In our Lent Groups (Monday 2.30pm and Thursdays 10.30am & 7.30pm) we will be sharing images of Christ from around the world and reflecting on the Scripture that inspired them – perhaps in your readings you may learn something more of Christ you might bring to those groups.

Each day also has a point for prayer and a point of action — choose to do with these what you wish — pray on your own or with others and try and put something of what you have read into action.

There are no entries for Sundays – this is deliberate as Sundays are not traditionally part of the Lenten fast, but are days to come together in worship and community as we meet together at 11am.

# Ash Wednesday 26th February

**Mark 1:1-8** *John the Baptist Prepares the way* 

**Prayer:** Give thanks for our church – we are all one body and Christ

is the head – ask that during Lent God would renew us and

show us His way.

**Action** Find a cross – it could be a wooden cross, or a piece of

jewellery, or a picture, and place it somewhere new to remind you to pause to focus on Christ each day in lent.

#### Thursday 27th February

**Mark 1: 9-15** In the wilderness. The Kingdom of God is near

**Prayer** Pray for those in our church and community who still need

to know Jesus as Lord. Pray that the Holy Spirit would reveal

Jesus to them.

**Action** Write down or tell someone your testimony today. What

does it mean for you to follow Jesus?

#### Friday 28th February

**Mark 1:16-20** *Called* 

**Prayer** Pray for our church leaders – that God will enable them,

protect them and sustain them as they do the task they are

called to.

**Action** Take some time to read or watch the news today – write

down the names of those people who are having to make decisions that affect others. Add them to your prayers over

the next few days.

#### Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> February

Mark 1:21-34 Jesus begins works of ministry

**Prayer** Pray for those who are struggling physically and mentally.

Pray particularly for the work we do as a church that

promotes positive mental wellbeing.

**Action** Exercise your body or your mind in some way today – giving

God thanks for it!

#### Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March

Mark 2:1-12 Jesus heals a paralyzed man

**Prayer** Give thanks to God for the good things you see happening

in our church and community.

**Action** Tell someone about something that has brought you joy

today.

#### Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March

Mark 2:13-28 Levi, wineskins and the Sabbath

**Prayer** Pray for those people you know who are working too hard

and never resting. If that is you, bring your burdens before

God today.

**Action** Do something to make life a little bit easier for someone

else today.

#### Wednesday 4th March

Mark 3:1-12 *Jesus our healer* 

**Prayer** Pray for the divisions in our community and country –

particularly for the divisions over Brexit.

**Action** Take some time to walk in the community today – pray

prayers of healing where you see brokenness. If you are not able to walk, find a window to look through or take a bus

ride, using the time to pray.

## Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March

Mark 3:13-35 *Jesus calls the twelve* 

**Prayer** Pray for all the volunteers in our church and community

family project. Pray that God will provide the people to

sustain the ministry to which we are called.

**Action** Explore opportunities for volunteering through the church

volunteering leaflet. If you are already volunteering, ask

God to help you to serve him with all of your heart.

#### Friday 6th March

Mark 4:1-20 The Parable of the Sower

**Prayer** Pray for the mission of the church through the Community

Family Project and pray that God would open opportunities

for us all to share our stories and faith with others

**Action** Plant some seeds and watch them grow

#### Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> March

Mark 4:21-34 The Kingdom of God

**Prayer** Pray for our work with Children and Young People which

has come to a natural end recently – pray that God will raise up leaders to take this work forward so we can reach out to Children, Young People and Families within our community

**Action** Make time today to ask someone from a different

generation to you about their day and, if appropriate, offer

to pray for them.

#### Monday 9th March

Mark 4:35-41 Jesus calms the storm

**Prayer** Pray for the families who receive food each week from our

delivery from Fareshare. Pray that they will find hope and

some of God's goodness in the coming week.

**Action** Bring a donation for our store cupboard which is used to

top up our Fareshare parcels when needed (ask Jo for the

kind of the things that would be helpful)

#### Tuesday 10th March

Mark 5:1-20 Jesus heals

**Prayer** Pray for those in our community who feel lonely. Pray that

God will help them to find places of belonging where they are accepted for who they are and where, if they need it,

they might find healing.

**Action** Contact someone you know who lives on their own or is

feeling lonely right now.

## Wednesday 11th March

Mark 5:21-43 Jesus, a girl and a woman

**Prayer** Pray for the women in our community. Pray for those who

for whom homelife is a struggle – for whatever reason. Pray

that they will feel loved and affirmed in who they are.

**Action** Take some time today to build up a female family member

or friend.

#### Thursday 12th March

Mark 6:1-29 Experiencing Opposition

**Prayer** Pray for the church in this country and across the world –

particularly pray for the persecuted church – for those who

stand up for their faith in difficult circumstances.

**Action** Do some research on the church across the world – either

on the internet or through the magazines we have in our

church entrance

#### Friday 13th March

**Mark 6:30-56** Feeding the 5000 and walking on water

**Prayer** For those in our community who do not have enough. Pray

for Make Lunch as we prepare for our two sessions in the

holidays and for those who will attend.

**Action** Donate some food to the Vine Foodbank

## Saturday 14th March

Mark 7:1-23 Discussions with the Pharisees

**Prayer** Pray for our Community Café and for Crafty Needles as they

create places of belonging

**Action** Think about how we can welcome people into our

community better. What could we change? How can we

welcome even those we disagree with?

#### Monday 16th March

Mark 7:24-30 The Syrophoenician Woman

**Prayer** Pray for our Wednesday Acorn Group – for all those attend

and for the difficult things they have to encounter in every

day life.

**Action** Take time today to say hello someone you wouldn't

normally talk to – a neighbour maybe? Make time for them.

#### Tuesday 17th March

Mark 7:31-37 Jesus heals a deaf and mute man

**Prayer** Pray for the men in our community and for the pressures

they are under. Pray that they will feel appreciated and

affirmed at home and at work.

**Action** Take time today to spend with a male friend or family

member and find out how they are doing. Offer to pray for

them if it is appropriate.

#### Wednesday 18th March

Mark 8: 1-21 Jesus feeds a crowd again

**Prayer** Pray for Chatterbox Toddler Group – for the new people

this term, for the relationships that are being built and for a

new leader to work alongside Chris.

**Action** Make plans to spend time with someone from church –

perhaps inviting them round or going out and having coffee with them (or make plans to come to the community café!)

#### Thursday 19th March

Mark 8:22-26 Jesus heals a blind man

**Prayer** Pray for those involved in making worship happen on a

Sunday – those who lead and preach and those who make sure all runs smoothly. Pray that God will rise up musicians

to play in services.

**Action** Sing or listen to one of your favourite worship songs.

Perhaps share it with somebody else

#### Friday 20th March

Mark 8:27-30 Who do you say I am?

**Prayer** Pray for family members and friends who have rejected

Jesus and who do not know him yet. Pray that they will discover who Jesus really is – that their eyes will be opened

and they will see him.

**Action** Find a way to show the love of Jesus to one of the people

you are praying for today.

#### Saturday 21st March

Mark 8:31-9:1 The Way of the Cross

**Prayer** Pray for the work of Evolve Peer Support Group and Nikki

who leads that group. Pray for growth in that group and for

those who attend.

**Action** Find that cross again that you put out to remind you at the

beginning of Lent and move it to somewhere new. When

was the last time you looked at it?

#### Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March

Mark 9:2-13 The Transfiguration

**Prayer** Pray for our relationships with other churches – both in

New Addington and with other local Baptist Churches.

**Action** Take positive action to make a change today – whether

that's giving something up or clearing a debt or finally volunteering for or giving to a cause that has been

challenging you.

#### Tuesday 24th March

Mark 9:14-29 The Demon-possessed boy

**Prayer** Sometimes we give up praying for something because God

hasn't answered. Pick up those prayers today and pray

them with all you heart.

**Action** Ask someone to pray for you today

#### Wednesday 25th March

Mark 9:30-37 Welcoming Children

**Prayer** Pray for our Sunday children's work and our church children

and their parents and carers and leaders - that we might

disciple them in the way of Christ well

**Action** Take time today to listen to something a child has to say

and pray for them

#### Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March

Mark 9:38-50 Stumbling Blocks

**Prayer** Pray for unity in our church – that God would unite us in our

vision. Pray that our Sunday worship would connect to our weekly work and that we all might see the bigger picture

**Action** Find out something new about church – perhaps about

something you have not been involved in before. Visit the church website or look at the leaflets – or ask someone!

#### Friday 27th March

Mark 10:1-16 Family Life

**Prayer** Pray for your own family and the families that make up the

church – for strong marriages and relationships and for those who have been hurt when things haven't worked out.

**Action** Make some time to spend today with your significant other

and/or children. If your family is not close by, make contact with them. If things with your family are a bit more difficult find a friend to pray with you for healing in the brokenness.

#### Saturday 28th March

**Mark 10:17-31** *Rich Man* 

**Prayer** Pray for justice – for those who have little to have more,

and for those who have more - to be generous with what

they have.

**Action** If you are able to, give something away today to someone

who needs it more than you do.

#### Monday 30th March

**Mark 10:32 – 45** *Who is the greatest?* 

**Prayer** Pray for those who are trapped in cycles of addiction – that

they might experience freedom

**Action** Think of a bad habit you have. Focus on that one thing and

seek to break the habit

#### Tuesday 31st March

Mark 10:46 – 52 Blind Bartimaeus

**Prayer** Pray for the partnerships we have with others in New

Addington – for Pathfinders who do a lot of work in the community, for Tramlink and the council who support our Community Family Project and all the other agencies

seeking to make this a better place.

**Action** Find out something new that is good that happens in the

community and share it with someone else

Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> April

Mark 11:1-11 Palm Sunday

**Prayer** Pray for joy and for laughter in our community. Pray that

people will find things to bring light into their lives.

**Action** Tell someone a joke or a funny story

Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April

Mark 11:12-25 The Cursed Fig Tree

**Prayer** Pray for our Church finances

**Action** Take time to look at your own finances. Are you doing with

them what God would want you to do?

#### Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April

Mark 11:27-33 By whose authority?

**Prayer** Pray for those in authority in New Addington and in our

country. Pray for wisdom and compassion in their decision

making.

**Action** Take time today to thank someone in authority for

something they have done.

#### Saturday 4th April

Mark 12:1-27 The Parable of the Talents and beyond

**Prayer** Pray for those who have no work or who don't feel valued

in their work today.

**Action** Think back to when Phil Barnard from the London Baptist

Association came and preached on this passage. What do you remember? What did you do in response? Pray for the LBA as they seek to lead the London Baptist Churches.

#### Monday 6<sup>th</sup> April

Mark 12:28-44 The greatest commandment

**Prayer and Action** At the beginning of Holy Week spend some time in God's

presence saying nothing, thinking nothing, just being still.

Let everything pass by. Simply notice what distracts you and

let it pass.

## Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> April

Mark 13 The tribulation

**Prayer** Pray for those places in the world that are experiencing

something of what you have read today.

**Action** Think of a way you can bring new hope in the world today

and put it into action

#### Wednesday 8th April

Mark 14:1-11 Jesus is Anointed

**Prayer** Reflect on your own Christian service. Ask God to show you

how you can serve his world

**Action** Deliberately get your hands dirty, and as you wash them,

reflect on how Jesus has made you clean.

## Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> April (Maundy Thursday)

Mark 14:12-72 The events of Maundy Thursday

**Prayer** Today remember, give thanks and sit listening to what Jesus

has to say to you

**Action** Join the rest of the church family for food and communion

this evening

## Friday 10th April (Good Friday)

Mark 15 The events of Good Friday

**Prayer** Pray for those who are struggling to believe.

**Action** Find that cross again, hold it, give thanks, and ask for

forgiveness.

## Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> April

**Psalm 22** Yesterday was Friday, but Sunday is coming

**Prayer** Ask God to increase the faith of the church, for new things

we can't even imagine and for boldness to step out in

faithfulness for the Kingdom's sake.

**Action** Draw around your shoe or boot. Write a prayer and ask God

for directions for the next steps in your life. Go to bed early praying this prayer ready to wake up to the new dawn with our Sonrise service tomorrow morning. Be ready to read

Mark 16:1-8 as you wake up......
